TOMCAT TAIL



A tomcat tail can occur in both male and female cats. A tomcat tail is often the worst at the top of the tail and is experienced by your cat as annoying and sometimes painful.

With some cats it is so bad that the sebaceous glands are inflamed, we recommend that you repeat the steps a few times.

If there are many cats in heat nearby, we recommend that you use the PrimeFulvic spray preventively.



PrimeFulvic spray from Humic Solution helps with a tomcat tail.

You use it as follows:

- 1. Wet the irritated area by spraying with the PrimeFulvic spray and then let it absorb.
- 2. When it is dry you will see that the sebum dissolves. When the sebum is dry, comb it out of the tail very carefully, for example with a flea comb.
- 3. After this, you can dust some dry powder such as cornstarch over it and brush it out of the tail after 24 hours.
- 4. Usually after these steps the hangover will disappear.
- 5. For inflamed sebaceous glands, repeat the above steps a few more times.
